FROM THE PASTOR

The Next Fifty Years

The 10th of next month we begin a year of commemorations leading up to June 10, 2023, when we will celebrate the 50th anniversary of the founding of St. Augustine Parish. This month more than 140 children will receive their first communion. Dressed in their white dresses and suits they will step to the altar and for the first time receive the Body of Christ, the sacrament through which God renews his presence in each of us: body, blood, soul, and divinity. Our faith tells us that Christ, the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity, God is truly given to us in the Eucharist.

And yet, I ask myself: In another 50 years how many of those making their first communion will still be regularly attending mass, here or anywhere? How many of them will have raised their children in the faith?

Each year more and more young adults pass into the category referred to as the “nones”, people who have given up not just their Catholic faith but all religion. Some remain vaguely spiritual, but many simply see no real value in religion. What religion are you? NONE.

In the last half of the 20th century, we failed. We failed to answer the most basic question: What difference does it make?

What difference does it make whether I go to church or not? What difference does it make whether I am Catholic or not?

As we look toward our second 50 years, we need find the best ways to communicate the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, that every human being is a unique creation of God and yet all created with the same ultimate purpose: to be united with God and with one another, united with the Body of Christ that subsists in the one, holy, catholic and apostolic church established by Jesus.

Los Próximos Cincuenta Años

El día 10 del próximo mes comenzamos un año de conmemoraciones hasta el 10 de junio de 2023, cuando celebraremos el 50 aniversario de la fundación de la Parroquia San Agustín. Este mes más de 140 niños recibirán su primera comunión. Ataviados con sus vestidos y trajes blancos, pisarán el altar y por primera vez recibirán el Cuerpo de Cristo, sacramento a través del cual Dios renueva su presencia en cada uno de nosotros: cuerpo, sangre, alma y divinidad. Nuestra fe nos dice que Cristo, la Segunda Persona de la Santísima Trinidad, Dios nos es verdaderamente dado en la Eucaristía.

Y, sin embargo, me pregunto: dentro de 50 años, ¿cuántos de los que hacen la primera comunión seguirán yendo a misa regularmente, aquí o en cualquier lugar? ¿Cuántos de ellos habrán criado a sus hijos en la fe?

Cada año, más y más adultos jóvenes pasan a la categoría conocida como los “ningunos”, personas que han renunciado no solo a su fe católica sino a toda religión. Algunos siguen siendo vagamente espirituales, pero muchos simplemente no ven ningún valor real en la religión. ¿De qué religión eres? NINGUNA.

En la última mitad del siglo XX, fracasamos. Fallamos en responder la pregunta más básica: ¿Qué diferencia hace?

¿Qué diferencia hace si voy a la iglesia o no? ¿Qué diferencia hay si soy católico o no?

Mientras miramos hacia nuestros segundos 50 años, necesitamos encontrar las mejores formas de comunicar la verdad del Evangelio de Jesucristo, que cada ser humano es una creación única de Dios y, sin embargo, todos fueron creados con el mismo propósito final: estar unidos con Dios y unos con otros, unidos al Cuerpo de Cristo que subsiste en la iglesia una, santa, católica y apostólica establecida por Jesús.

FORMACIÓN CRISTIANA

Registration for Religious Education and Sacramental Preparation for adults & for school-aged children and youth will take place as follows:

- † Sunday July 10, 10:00am-4:00pm in the parish hall
- † Wednesday July 27, 5:30pm-7:30pm in PC 1-2
- † Tuesday August 9, 5:30pm-7:30pm in PC 1-2
- † Sunday August 21, 10:00am-4:00pm in the parish hall

NOTES:

- ⇒ To register your son/daughter for 1st Communion, your child must be Baptized and entering 2nd grade (or higher) or have turned 7 years of age (or older);
- ⇒ to register your child for Confirmation, s/he must be Baptized, have received Communion and be entering 10th grade (or higher) or have turned 15 years of age (or older)
- ⇒ Registrations are taken on a first-come first served basis until we reach capacity. Once we reach capacity, we begin a waiting list
- ⇒ Programs begin end of September-beginning of October
- ⇒ If you are registering your son/daughter for first Communion or Confirmation we will need a copy of his/her Baptism certificate (and for Confirmation, a copy of the first Communion certificate) unless they've received the Sacraments here at St. Augustine's. You can bring the copy when you register or at a later time.
- ⇒ Payments for fees can be made at registration or at a later date when programs have started (we accept cash, checks, and credit cards).

Q: Can I get married in the Church if I have not been Confirmed?

A: If you are a Baptized Catholic, you can get married in the Catholic Church, even if you have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation. That said, the Church encourages you to prepare for Confirmation if doing so is not overly burdensome.

NOTAS:

- ⇒ Para inscribir a su hijo para la 1ª Comunión, el/ella debe ser bautizado/a, estar por entrar a 2º grado (o más), o habido cumplido 7 años de edad (o mayor);
- ⇒ Para inscribir a su hijo/a para la Confirmación, el/ella debe ser bautizado/a, recibido la 1ª Comunión y estar entrando en 10º grado (o más), o haber cumplido los 15 años de edad (o mayor)
- ⇒ Tomamos las inscripciones por orden de llegada mientras haya lugar. Una vez que los programas estén llenos, comenzamos anotando gente en la lista de espera
- ⇒ Los programas comienzan a fines de septiembre-principios de octubre
- ⇒ Si usted quiere inscribir a su hijo/a para la primera Comunión o para la Confirmación, vamos a necesitar copia del certificado de bautismo (y para Confirmación, también copia del certificado de primera Comunión) a menos que haya recibido estos sacramentos en San Agustín). Puede traer la copia cuando los inscribe o más adelante.
- ⇒ Puede hacer pago para el programa cuando completa la inscripción o más adelante cuando haya empezado el programa (tomamos efectivo, cheque, y tarjeta de crédito).

P: ¿Puedo casarme en la iglesia si no he recibido el sacramento de la confirmación?

R: Si eres una persona bautizada católica, puedes casarte en la iglesia católica aunque no hayas recibido el sacramento de la confirmación. Eso dicho, la iglesia recomienda que te prepares para el sacramento de la confirmación si te es posible.

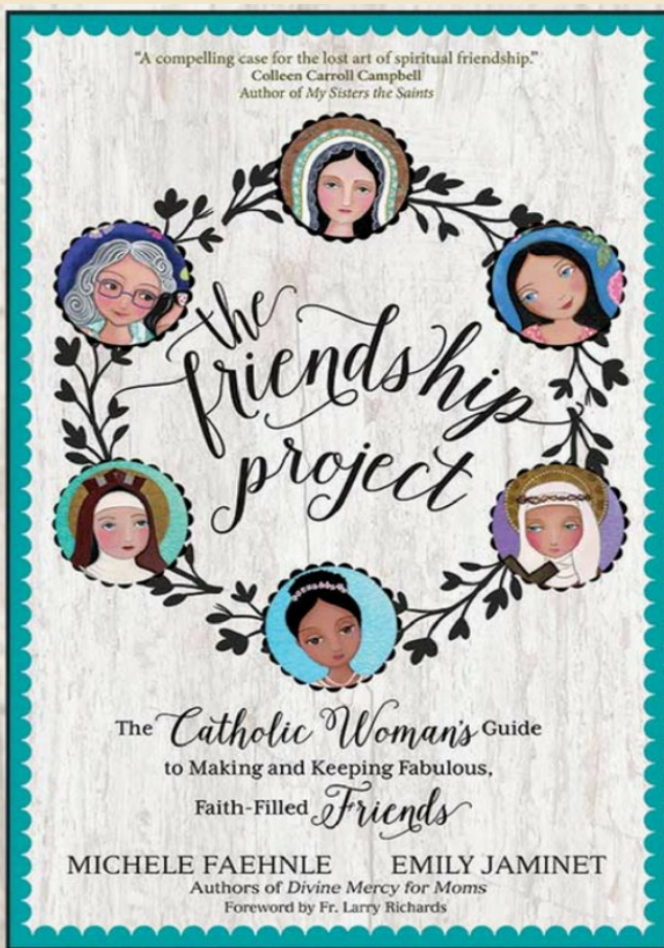
