FROM THE PASTOR

50 Years and Beyond

This weekend we celebrate the first 50 years of St. Augustine Parish. The Church defines a parish as “a certain community of the Christian faithfully constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a priest as its proper pastor under the authority of the diocesan bishop.” On June 10, 1973, the Solemnity of Pentecost, Bishop John Russell decreed that St. Augustine Parish be established to provide pastoral care to all Catholics and to evangelize all those living in a large swath of Chesterfield County touching the Richmond City limits in the north and the Dinwiddie County line in the south.

For 50 years, our parish has carried out that mission and adapted to the ever-changing needs of the area. Today we have more than 3000 families who have registered in our parish and even more who regularly participate in our masses in person and on-line. Our Spanish language Facebook page has more than 7000 followers, and technology allows us to reunite families for those pivotal moments of sorrow and joy.

As we complete our first 50 years, we pray for the Holy Spirit to continue to guide us and inspire to so that we can continue to adapt as our portion of Chesterfield County continues to grow and change. May the Holy Spirit teach us to use wisely all the tools at our disposal to proclaim the Gospel and invite all those who live around us to be a part of this community. May we in union with our bishop and the Holy Father continue to show to the world that we are truly the “one, holy, catholic and apostolic” Church established by Christ. And may our parish children live to celebrate the 100th anniversary of our parish in 2073.

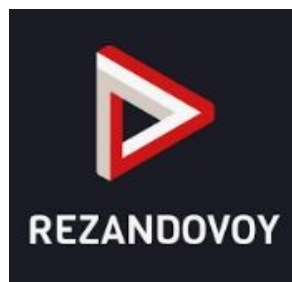

The Catholic Diocese of Richmond is seeking a Director of Campus Ministry to serve the Catholic Campus Ministry communities of Virginia Military Institute and Washington and Lee University in Lexington, VA.

Virginia Military Institute is a public institution in the military tradition with an enrollment of 1,700 undergraduate cadets. Washington and Lee University is a private, liberal arts school with an enrollment of 2,175.

The Director of Campus Ministry is responsible for the development, implementation, and oversight of a comprehensive campus ministry program for the students of Virginia Military Institute and Washington and Lee University.
