FROM THE PASTOR

Change for the Future

St. John Henry Newman said, “To live is to change and to be perfect is to have changed often.”

Here in our parish, there are lots of changes. As I have mentioned before, Deacon Ramon Rivera is coming on July 17. Fr. Julz Buena is coming July 1.

In addition, both Angy Corrigan and Amanda Roberts have determined that it is time for them to transition out of their positions. We thank them for their years of service to the parish and wish the well in whatever path the Lord leads them.

The change has given us a chance to re-envision the positions in the staff. We will be looking to hire two people to focus on our children, the future of the Church.

The first position will be a Director of Children’s Formation. This person will be responsible for the ministry to children in grades K-8. This will include sacramental preparations, Children’s Liturgy, and all activities for our elementary and middle school age children.

The second position will be a Director of Youth Ministry. Here we are looking for someone who can coordinate our parents and other volunteers to provide not only sacramental preparation but a variety of other activities to engage our high schoolers at the parish level, and the level of the diocese, and beyond.

We must focus on not just sacraments but on giving our children and true sense of their Catholic identity and why faith is essential to their lives.

Cambio Para el Futuro

St. John Henry Newman dijo: “Vivir es cambiar y ser perfecto es haber cambiado a menudo”.

Aquí en nuestra parroquia, hay muchos cambios. Como mencioné antes, el Diácono Ramón Rivera viene el 17 de julio. El Padre Julz Buena llegará el 1º de julio.

Además, tanto Angy Corrigan como Amanda Roberts han determinado que es hora de que hagan la transición fuera de sus puestos. Les agradecemos por sus años de servicio a la parroquia y les deseamos lo mejor en cualquier camino que el Señor les lleve.

El cambio nos ha dado la oportunidad de volver a visualizar las posiciones en el personal. Buscaremos contratar a dos personas para que se centren en nuestros hijos, el futuro de la Iglesia.

El primer puesto será un Director de Formación para Niños. Esta persona será responsable del ministerio de niños en los grados K-8. Esto incluirá preparaciones sacramentales, Liturgia Para Niños y todas las actividades para nuestros niños en edad de escuela primaria y secundaria.

El segundo puesto será un Director de Ministerio para Jóvenes. Aquí estamos buscando a alguien que pueda coordinar a nuestros padres y otros voluntarios para brindar no solo preparación sacramental sino una variedad de otras actividades para involucrar a nuestros estudiantes de secundaria a nivel parroquial, a nivel de la diócesis y más allá.

Debemos enfocarnos no solo en los sacramentos, sino en darles a nuestros hijos un verdadero sentido de su identidad católica y por qué la fe es esencial para sus vidas.

CHRISTIAN FORMATION

Q&A: Godparents for Infant Baptism

Q: What are the requirements for godparents for my child's Baptism?

A: For the Baptism of an infant or child, you need a minimum of 1 godparent. This person needs to sign a form attesting that he/she fulfills the following requirements:

- Ⓐ Is at least 16 years old
- Ⓐ Is a Baptized Catholic who has been Confirmed and has received the blessed Eucharist
- Ⓐ Is not bound by a canonical penalty
- Ⓐ May be single or married. If married, in a marriage recognized by the Catholic Church (ie. not only civilly married); if single, not living with his/her partner without being married
- Ⓐ Is leading a life of faith befitting the role to be undertaken (for example, regularly attending Sunday Mass)
- Ⓐ Is not a parent of the child
- You may have 2 godparents for your child in which case it must be one male, one female (not 2 male nor 2 female). If they are married, they don't need to be married to each other (but can be; either way they do need to fulfill the requirements)
- You may have 1 Catholic godparent (who fulfills the above requirements) and 1 Christian witness (who is a Baptized Christian but not Catholic); a baptized Catholic who is not Confirmed (and/or who hasn't received Communion) may not serve as a Christian witness
- For infant Baptisms, godparents should attend the preparation session with the parents.

P: I heard that I only need a Christian witness.

R: You may have a Christian witness for your child's Baptism but you still need to also have one Catholic godparent who fulfills all the requirements listed above. A Christian witness alone does not meet the requirements as outlined in Canon law.

FORMACIÓN CRISTIANA

Preguntas y Respuestas: Padrinos para bautismo de niños

P: ¿Cuáles son los requisitos para padrinos para el bautismo de mi niño?

R: Para el bautismo de un niño, necesita como mínimo 1 padrino o madrina. Quien va a ser padrino/madrina debe firmar un formulario atestiguando que cumple los siguientes requisitos:

- Ⓐ Que ha cumplido 16 años
- Ⓐ Que han recibido los sacramentos del Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía en la Iglesia Católica
- Ⓐ Que no está afectado por una pena canónica
- Ⓐ Puede ser soltero o casado. Si casado, debe estar casado de acuerdo a las normas de la iglesia católica (no solo por civil); si soltero, no puede estar conviviendo con su pareja sin estar casados
- Ⓐ Que lleva una vida cristiana congruente con la fe y apropiada con el rol que va a desempeñar (ej. Asistir regularmente a misa los domingos)
- Ⓐ Que no es el padre/madre del niño/a
- Puede tener 2 padrinos. En este caso debe ser un varón y una mujer (no puede ser 2 hombres ni 2 mujeres). Pueden estar casados (cumpliendo los requisitos), y no necesariamente casados el uno al otro.
- Puede tener un padrino/madrina católico/a (que cumple con todos los requisitos) y un testigo cristiano (o sea, bautizado Cristiano pero no Católico/a; una persona bautizada Católica que no tiene todos sus sacramentos de iniciación no puede servir como testigo cristiano).
- Para el bautismo de infantes, los padrinos deben atender la charla con los padres.

P: Yo escuché que puedo tener testigo cristiano solamente.

R: Puede tener un testigo cristiano para el bautismo de su niño pero no solamente un testigo cristiano. Si tiene un testigo cristiano, también necesita un padrino/madrina católico/a que cumple con todos los requisitos enumerado. Un testigo cristiano solo, no cumple los requisitos establecidos en la ley canónica.

Virginia Military Institute is a public institution in the military tradition with an enrollment of 1,700 undergraduate cadets. Washington and Lee University is a private, liberal arts school with an enrollment of 2,175.

The Director of Campus Ministry is responsible for the development, implementation, and oversight of a comprehensive campus ministry program for the students of Virginia Military Institute and Washington and Lee University.
