FROM THE PASTOR

Eucharistic Revival

It is easy for us to forget about things like the year dedicated to the Eucharistic Revival. For that reason, I am writing this. Just as a reminder to all of us.

The Second Vatican Council called the Eucharist “the source and summit of the Church’s action.” It is the truly the Body of Christ, and Christ is the source of everything we do as a Church. It is the summit, in that, the goal of our human life is eternity with God and in this life.

This year is a time for all of us to ask how important we really consider the Eucharist in our lives. Do we really believe that Christ is truly present in the Eucharist?

We have many retired people in our English language community. For that reason, we offer daily mass Tuesday-Thursday at 9 AM. What are you doing at 9 AM? Are you at work or are you just at home? How hard would it be to, at least once during the week, make the little extra effort to come to church?

And if you cannot make it to mass during the week, can you find some time to simply stop by the church and pray? We reserve the Eucharist in the tabernacle not only so that we can take it to the sick but also so that we can spend time close to our Lord, as He is uniquely present in the Blessed Sacrament.

The Church has set aside this year for Eucharistic Revival so that all of us may deepen our connection to Christ who offers himself to us in this way.

MENSAJE DEL PÁRROCO

Avivamiento Eucarístico

Es fácil para nosotros olvidarnos de cosas como el año dedicado al Avivamiento Eucarístico. Por eso, estoy escribiendo esto. Solo como un recordatorio para todos nosotros.

El Concilio Vaticano II llamó a la Eucaristía "la fuente y la cumbre de la acción de la Iglesia." Es verdaderamente el Cuerpo de Cristo, y Cristo es la fuente de todo lo que hacemos como Iglesia. Es la cumbre, en eso, la meta de nuestra vida humana es la eternidad con Dios y en esta vida.

Este año es un momento para que todos nos preguntemos cuán importante consideramos realmente la Eucaristía en nuestras vidas. ¿Realmente creemos que Cristo está verdaderamente presente en la Eucaristía?

Tenemos muchas personas jubiladas en nuestra comunidad de habla inglesa. Por esa razón, ofrecemos misa diaria de martes a jueves a las 9 AM. ¿Qué estás haciendo a las 9 AM? ¿Estás en el trabajo o solo estás en casa? ¿Qué tan difícil sería, al menos una vez durante la semana, hacer el pequeño esfuerzo extra para venir a la iglesia?

Y si no puedes asistir a misa durante la semana, ¿puedes encontrar algo de tiempo para simplemente pasar por la iglesia y orar? Reservamos la Eucaristía en el tabernáculo no solo para poder llevarla a los enfermos, sino también para que podamos pasar tiempo cerca de nuestro Señor, ya que Él está presente de manera única en el Santísimo Sacramento.

La Iglesia ha reservado este año para el avivamiento eucarístico para que todos podamos profundizar nuestra conexión con Cristo que se ofrece a nosotros de esta manera.

Q&A: Godparents for Infant Baptism

Q: What are the requirements for godparents for my child's Baptism?

A: For the Baptism of an infant or child, you need a minimum of 1 godparent. This person needs to sign a form attesting that he/she fulfills the following requirements:

- Ⓐ Is at least 16 years old
- Ⓐ Is a Baptized Catholic who has been Confirmed and has received the blessed Eucharist
- Ⓐ Is not bound by a canonical penalty
- Ⓐ May be single or married. If married, in a marriage recognized by the Catholic Church (ie. not only civilly married); if single, not living with his/her partner without being married
- Ⓐ Is leading a life of faith befitting the role to be undertaken (for example, regularly attending Sunday Mass)
- Ⓐ Is not a parent of the child
- You may have 2 godparents for your child in which case it must be one male, one female (not 2 male nor 2 female). If they are married, they don't need to be married to each other (but can be; either way they do need to fulfill the requirements)
- You may have 1 Catholic godparent (who fulfills the above requirements) and 1 Christian witness (who is a Baptized Christian but not Catholic); a baptized Catholic who is not Confirmed (and/or who hasn't received Communion) may not serve as a Christian witness
- For infant Baptisms, godparents should attend the preparation session with the parents.

P: I heard that I only need a Christian witness.

R: You may have a Christian witness for your child's Baptism but you still need to also have one Catholic godparent who fulfills all the requirements listed above. A Christian witness alone does not meet the requirements as outlined in Canon law.

INSCRIPCIÓN

Preguntas y Respuestas: Padrinos para bautismo de niños

P: ¿Cuáles son los requisitos para padrinos para el bautismo de mi niño?

R: Para el bautismo de un niño, necesita como mínimo 1 padrino o madrina. Quien va a ser padrino/madrina debe firmar un formulario atestiguando que cumple los siguientes requisitos:

- Ⓐ Que ha cumplido 16 años
- Ⓐ Que han recibido los sacramentos del Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía en la Iglesia Católica
- Ⓐ Que no está afectado por una pena canónica
- Ⓐ Puede ser soltero o casado. Si casado, debe estar casado de acuerdo a las normas de la iglesia católica (no solo por civil); si soltero, no puede estar conviviendo con su pareja sin estar casados
- Ⓐ Que lleva una vida cristiana congruente con la fe y apropiada con el rol que va a desempeñar (ej. Asistir regularmente a misa los domingos)
- Ⓐ Que no es el padre/madre del niño/a
- Puede tener 2 padrinos. En este caso debe ser un varón y una mujer (no puede ser 2 hombres ni 2 mujeres). Pueden estar casados (cumpliendo los requisitos), y no necesariamente casados el uno al otro.
- Puede tener un padrino/madrina católico/a (que cumple con todos los requisitos) y un testigo cristiano (o sea, bautizado Cristiano pero no Católico/a; una persona bautizada Católica que no tiene todos sus sacramentos de iniciación no puede servir como testigo cristiano).
- Para el bautismo de infantes, los padrinos deben atender la charla con los padres.

P: Yo escuché que puedo tener testigo cristiano solamente.

R: Puede tener un testigo cristiano para el bautismo de su niño pero no solamente un testigo cristiano. Si tiene un testigo cristiano, también necesita un padrino/madrina católico/a que cumple con todos los requisitos enumerado. Un testigo cristiano solo, no cumple los requisitos establecidos en la ley canónica.

JOB OPENINGS

Follow Your Vocation to Serve

Do you think you may be called to serve the Church in a new role? The Office of the Permanent Diaconate is hosting three informational sessions this fall for men who might have a calling to ordained service to the Church and to the bishop as a permanent deacon, and are interested in discerning their calling while learning about the commitment it involves.

Qualifications for formation to the permanent diaconate include, but are not limited to the following:

- A Roman Catholic for a minimum of five years at time of application.
- Registered parishioner within the Diocese of Richmond for five years at the time of application, and active in the parish community.
