FROM THE PASTOR

Loving Your Neighbor in Practice

In this season of Lent, we try to better live the two commandments: to love God and to love our neighbor. Sometimes when we think of loving our neighbor we think only of acts of charity such as giving food to the hungry. But more difficult are the acts that require us to change.

Last week I wrote about some changes we're going to make to parking. But the most important change is a change within the individual. How and where I park my car clearly indicates whether I love my neighbor or not.

For example, our neighbor is Beulah Church. No one, other than the parishioners of Beulah Church, has the right to park in their parking lot. As an act of charity, they have given us permission to use a portion of their parking lot.

To love one's neighbor means to respect the person and their property. They allow us to use their parking lot and we have an obligation to respect them and their property. When we throw trash in the parking lot, we don't love our neighbors. When we block the traffic lane, we don't love our neighbor. When we park our cars on the grass, we don't love our neighbors. When we are not handicapped and park the car in a handicapped reserved spot, we do not love our neighbor.

Only the egotist thinks, "I have the right to park anywhere." The Christian thinks of his neighbor first, he puts his neighbor first.

Is it always convenient to love one's neighbor? No. Sometimes it is very inconvenient to love your neighbor. But God does not command us to love when it suits us, God commands us to love always. Loving one's neighbor is inconvenient. Loving our neighbor costs us something.

Lent is a time of conversion, of penance, and penance always costs us something. Love is the ability to sacrifice for the good of others.

MENSAJE DEL PÁRROCO

Amar al Prójimo en Práctica

En este tiempo de cuaresma, tratamos de vivir mejor los dos mandamientos: amar a Dios, y amar al prójimo. A veces cuando pensamos en amar al prójimo pensamos solamente actos de caridad como dar comida a hambriento. Pero más difícil son los actos que requieren que cambiemos.

La semana pasada escribí sobre unos cambios que vamos a hacer al parqueo. Pero el cambio más importante un cambio interno al individuo. Como y donde estaciono mi carro indica claramente si amo a mi prójimo o no.

Por ejemplo, el prójimo, el vecino nuestro es Beulah Church. Nadie, aparte de los feligreses de Beulah Church, tiene el derecho de estacionarse en su parqueo. Como acto de caridad, ellos nos han dado permiso de utilizar una parte de su parqueo.

Amar al prójimo quiere decir respetar a la persona y a su propiedad. Ellos permiten que usemos su parqueo y nosotros tenemos la obligación de respetarlo. Cuando tiramos basura en el parqueo no amamos al prójimo. Cuando bloqueamos al carril no amamos al prójimo. Cuando estacionamos el carro en el césped, no amamos al prójimo. Cuando no somos discapacitados y estacionamos el carro en lugar de discapacitados, no amamos al prójimo.

Solo el egoísta piensa, "Yo tengo derecho de estacionarme dondequiera." El cristiano piensa primero en el prójimo, pone el prójimo en primer lugar.

¿Es siempre conveniente amar al prójimo? No. A veces es muy inconveniente amar al prójimo. Pero Dios no nos manda amar cuando nos conviene, Dios nos manda amar siempre. Amar al prójimo es inconveniente. Amar al prójimo nos cuesta.

La cuaresma es tiempo de conversión, de penitencia, y la penitencia siempre nos cuesta. El amor es la capacidad de sacrificarse para el bien de otros.
