FROM THE PASTOR

Time to Breathe!

We are now being bombarded by information; from the time we wake up until the time we go to bed. What makes it worse is that we are expected to respond to much of it. Most of us have become addicted, yes addicted, to some electronic device. Get separated from your cell phone and notice how you feel. For most of us, it is a kind of panic. What's worse is that we think of it as normal.

Maybe you are of a slightly older generation and maybe it isn't the phone. Maybe it is the television. You live alone and so you keep the television on all day long. This is no less an addiction. It is a dependence on some thing. The sound of the television makes you feel less alone.

The problem with all of this is that it is contrary to how God made us. Did God make us to be dependent? Yes. We are built to be dependent on Him and on one another. We are built to be in relationship: relationship with God and with other people.

Relationships are built through conversation, through sharing our deeper parts of ourselves one with another. That conversation with God we call "prayer."

Whether actual human conversation or conversation with God, all conversation requires time and attention. We must stop and pay attention. Christian tradition has always taught us that we need to do this at least twice a day: in the morning and in the evening.

Firstly, if the first thing we do when we wake up is grab the phone, perhaps we need to set the phone further from the bed.

Secondly, it is good for us to establish a set time at night when we stop, when we put the phone down, turn off the television or the computer, allow our minds to relax, and raise our hearts and minds to God.

This sounds simple but I think if we try it, we will discover it is harder than we think.

MENSAJE DEL PÁRROCO

¡Es hora de respirar!

Ahora estamos siendo bombardeados de información; desde que nos despertamos hasta que nos acostamos. Lo que lo empeora es que se espera que respondamos a gran parte de ello. La mayoría de nosotros nos hemos vuelto adictos, sí, adictos, a algún dispositivo electrónico. Aléjate de tu celular y observa cómo te sientes. Para la mayoría de nosotros, es una especie de pánico. Lo peor es que lo pensamos como algo normal.

Tal vez seas de una generación un poco mayor y tal vez no sea el teléfono. Tal vez sea la televisión. Vives solo y por eso mantienes la televisión encendida todo el día. Esto no deja de ser una adicción. Es una dependencia de alguna cosa. El sonido de la televisión te hace sentir menos solo.

El problema con todo esto es que es contrario a cómo Dios nos hizo. ¿Nos hizo Dios para ser dependientes? Sí. Estamos hechos para depender de Él y de los demás. Estamos hechos para estar en relación: relación con Dios y con otras personas.

Las relaciones se construyen a través de la conversación, compartiendo nuestras partes más profundas de nosotros mismos unos con otros. A esa conversación con Dios la llamamos "oración".

Ya sea una conversación humana real o una conversación con Dios, toda conversación requiere tiempo y atención. Debemos detenernos y prestar atención. La tradición cristiana siempre nos ha enseñado que debemos hacer esto al menos dos veces al día: por la mañana y por la noche.

En primer lugar, si lo primero que hacemos al despertar es coger el teléfono, quizás necesitamos ponerlo más alejado de la cama.

En segundo lugar, es bueno que establezcamos un tiempo fijo por la noche en el que nos detengamos, cuando dejemos el teléfono, apaguemos la televisión o la computadora, permitamos que nuestras mentes se relajen y elevemos nuestros corazones y mentes a Dios.

Esto suena simple, pero creo que si lo intentamos, descubriremos que es más difícil de lo que pensamos.
