FROM THE PASTOR

Getting Comfortable with Silence

Since the beginning of Lent, we have been maintaining silence during periods of adoration. This can be difficult for those who are new to it because we live in a world of constant noise and stimulation. The Church uses the phrase "sacred silence" to remind us that silence is a privileged place of encounter with the divine.

Silence also allows each person in the space to encounter Christ in their own way. For one person, it may help to have a Bible or other spiritual reading. One of the most powerful forms of prayer is to read a passage from the life of Jesus in one of the gospels and then meditate on it with Christ in the Blessed Sacrament.

For another person, it may help to pray the rosary in the silence of their heart. For beginners, it may be necessary to break up the silence by putting in earphones and listening to some reflective music from your phone to calm the noise of your mind.

The beauty of silent adoration is that no matter your age, language, culture, or spirituality, everyone can equally encounter Christ. There are 168 hours in a week. All of us should be able to dedicate at least 1% of that time to "sacred silence."

For a deeper look, I recommend Cardinal Sarah's book, *The Power of Silence: Against the Dictatorship of Noise*.

MENSAJE DEL PÁRROCO

Sentirse Cómodo con el Silencio

Desde el comienzo de la Cuaresma, hemos estado manteniendo el silencio durante los períodos de adoración. Esto puede ser difícil para aquellos que son nuevos en ello, porque vivimos en un mundo de ruido y estimulación constante. La Iglesia usa la frase "silencio sagrado" para recordarnos que el silencio es un lugar privilegiado de encuentro con lo divino.

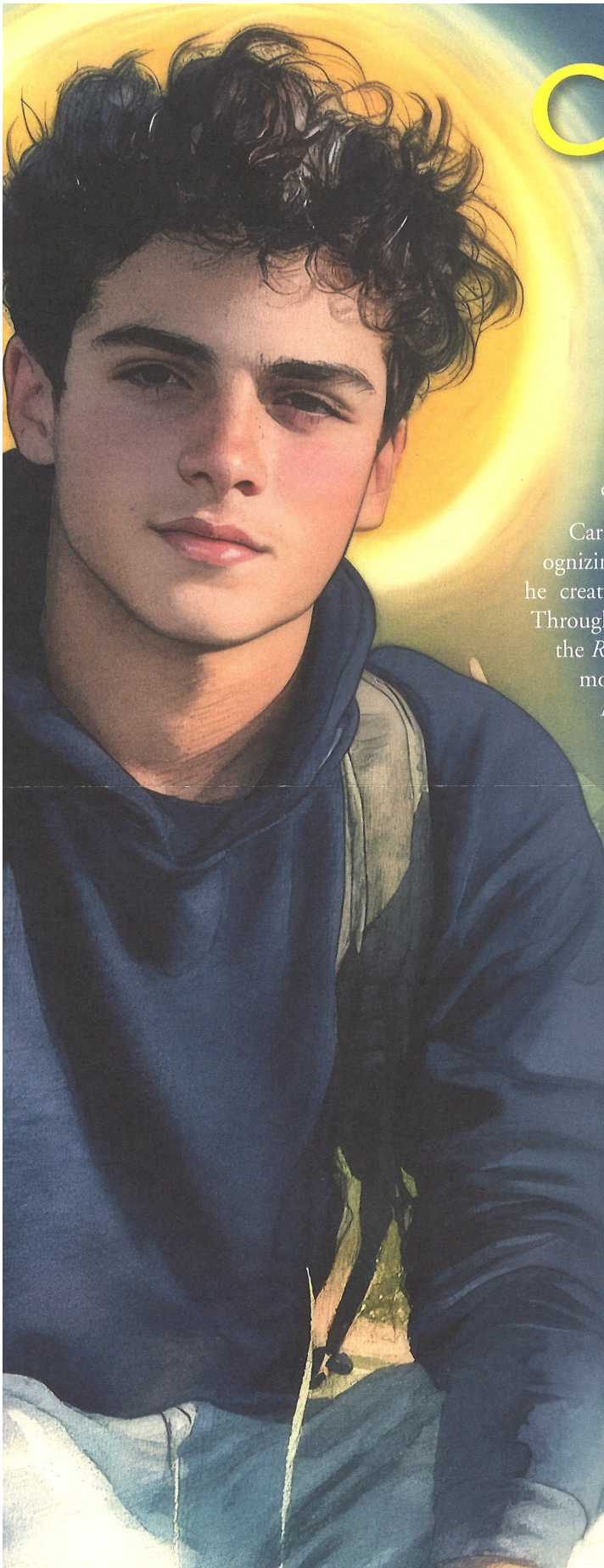
El silencio también permite que cada persona en el espacio encuentre a Cristo a su manera. Para una persona, puede ser útil tener una Biblia u otra lectura espiritual. Una de las formas más poderosas de oración es leer un pasaje de la vida de Jesús en uno de los evangelios y luego meditar sobre él con Cristo en el Santísimo Sacramento.

Para otra persona, puede ser útil rezar el rosario en el silencio de su corazón. Para los principiantes, puede ser necesario interrumpir el silencio poniéndose auriculares y escuchando música reflexiva desde su teléfono para calmar el ruido de su mente.

La belleza de la adoración silenciosa es que, sin importar su edad, idioma, cultura o espiritualidad, todos pueden encontrar a Cristo por igual. Hay 168 horas en una semana. Todos deberíamos poder dedicar al menos el 1% de ese tiempo al "silencio sagrado".

Para una mirada más profunda, recomiendo el libro del Cardenal Sarah, *"La Fuerza del Silencio: Contra la Dictadura del Ruido."*

Si tiene dificultad para oír durante la Misa, tenemos aparatos auditivos disponibles en la Sacristía para aquellos que tienen audífonos o no.



Carlo Acutis

THE FIRST MILLENNIAL SAINT

Carlo Acutis, born in 1991 in Milan, Italy, is celebrated as the first millennial to be sainted, highlighting his faith and influence on modern Catholicism. From a young age, Carlo displayed a unique spirituality. Raised in a family with limited religious practice, he developed a personal devotion to the Eucharist, attending daily Mass and spending hours in adoration. His spiritual maturity was evident in his frequent prayers, especially the Rosary, and his dedication to helping others.

Carlo's love for technology became central to his mission. Recognizing the potential of the internet as a tool for evangelization, he created a website cataloging eucharistic miracles worldwide. Through this, he sought to inspire others to deepen their faith in the *Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist*. Carlo's integration of modern tools with ancient truths earned him the title "Cyber Apostle of the Eucharist."

Beyond technology, Carlo's virtues shone in daily life. Known for humility, kindness, he frequently helped the poor and defended peers. His mantra, "We are all born originals, but many die as photocopies," encouraged others to embrace their unique paths to holiness.

In 2006, Carlo was diagnosed with leukemia. Even amid suffering, he maintained deep trust in God, offering his pain for the Church and the Pope. He faced death with serene acceptance, passing away at 15. Following his beatification in 2020 by Pope Francis, Carlo is to be canonized on April 27, 2025, in recognition of miracles attributed to his intercession in 2013 and 2022, as acknowledged by the Vatican.

Carlo's legacy inspires youth worldwide, showing that sainthood is attainable today. His life offers a blueprint for using technology to spread love and truth. Carlo reminds us that holiness is not bound by age or circumstance but found in living for God and others. His story inspires generations to seek God's presence and live authentically as "originals."

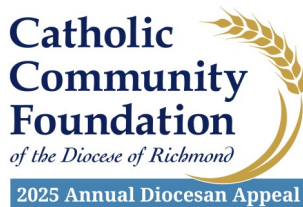

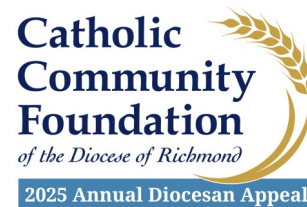
A Message from Fr. Wayne
